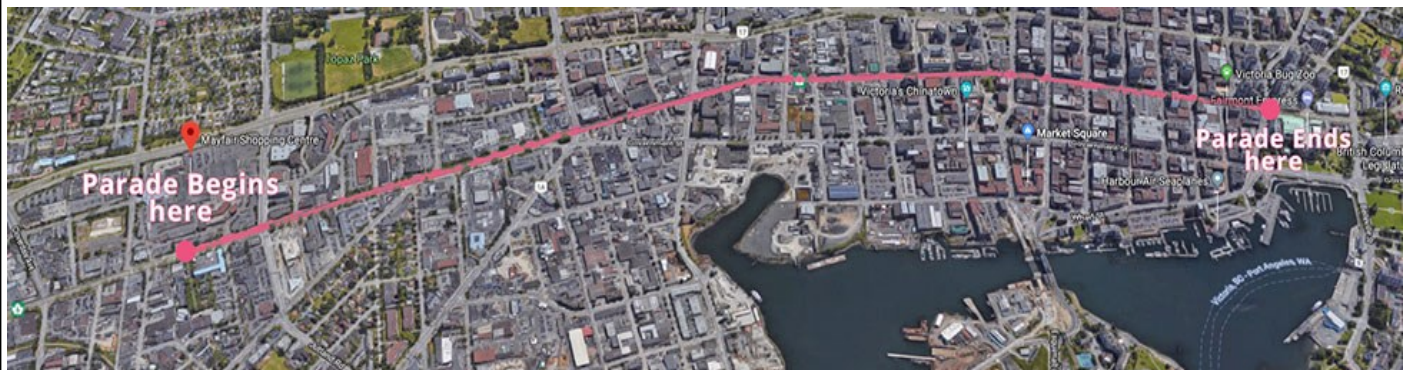

## 2022 Victoria Day Parade

The parade returns in its usual grand-scale format on **May 23rd, 2022**. This year the event honours all of the frontline employees and healthcare workers who have been busy during the pandemic.
